



# **Seaford Invitational Karate** **Championships 2010** **REPORT AND RESULTS**



Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> June 2010 saw Seaford Karate Club host the third Invitational Karate Tournament at the Downs Leisure Centre. The entry was slightly down on last year with about 130 competitors taking part but that still meant we had good size categories and plenty of competition ahead.

Our chief referees this year saw Ben Brown (ASKA), Alan White (ASK) and Barry Lovett (CMA) take charge starting with the weapons kata taking centre stage. Karl Mason from Sneyd karate club won the event using double Kama, while his younger brother performed a Bo kata to take silver and bronze went to Daniel Fountain (Tokon kai) using the Nunchuka.

The team kata events followed and the novice and intermediate events were won by Debi Steven's Funakoshi karate club. In the senior category Seaford 'A' took the gold followed by Tokon kai and Seaford 'B' in bronze.

In the first individual event of the day 7 years and below kata, Hannah Marwood from FSKA won the gold medal beating 18 other competitors over two rounds with Piranavan Selvamanoharam (BASK) in silver and Parul Pankhania (SKO) in bronze.

The largest category of the day saw 21 competitors perform over two rounds in the 8-10 years old novice to 7<sup>th</sup> kyu with Anjenna Vijaykumar (BASK) winning the gold with club mate Seyon Srishanger in silver, and bronze going to Spike King from (FSKA). In the 6<sup>th</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> Kyu division Rohan Mathiyalagan (BASK) reigned supreme with Birmingham's Jamie Allison in silver and Lewis Finch (Seaford) taking the bronze medal.

In the boys and girls 11-15 categories novice to 7<sup>th</sup> Kyu was won by Lagani Navaneethakrishan (BASK) followed by Indy Sagoo (SKO) in Silver and Dhanya Yogaratnam in Bronze from BASK. In the intermediate section the students battled it out with Janani Hariskandaraj from BASK winning the gold followed by team mate Asvin Puneswararajah and bronze going to Ishan Nandra from SKO Southall.

In the brown belt section Jatinder Ram (SKO Southall) went one better than last year beating the other 10 competitors to the gold medal with Matthew Delaloye (Seaford) taking the silver and Riccardo Francolini from Birmingham finishing with the Bronze. Jack Mason from Sneyd Karate club dominated the black belt section followed by Emily Delaloye (Seaford) winning silver and beating last years winner Daniel Fountain (Tokon Kai) in a third round tie break.

The male novice to 4<sup>th</sup> Kyu adults saw Tarandip Chana from BASK winning the gold with team mates Markandu Keerthishanker and Arulananthasamy taking silver and bronze respectively.

In the Ladies novice kata Ellie Reynolds from Complete Martial Arts (CMA) took the honours winning the event followed by Nathalie Boden from Seaford in silver and Sandeep Kaur (SKO) taking the bronze. The female senior kata was dominated by Sian Pomeroy from Seaford with Chloe Sutherland from CMA in silver and Tina Tung from SKO Southall taking a bronze.

The male senior kata saw 14 competitors battle it out for supremacy with Karl Mason from Sneyd dominating the two rounds performing Unsu and winning the gold while silver went to Jasmeet Singh from SKO Southall and bronze to Sellathurai Ganeshalingam from BASK. The Masters open kata was won for a third consecutive year by Sellathurai Ganeshalingam from BASK with Malcolm Johnstone from Tokon Kai taking a well earned silver medal as runner up.

After a short lunch break for the referees the kumite kicked off with the Men's team event. Four teams battled it out and the final saw Seaford 'A', who beat SKO Southall face up against the ASKA team who had beaten the BASK team in the semi final. In the final the first fight saw Colin Simmonds go four points down before pulling it back to win 8-4. The second round was also won by the ASKA fighter 3-0 and gave them the gold medal with Seaford taking silver, with semi finalists SKO and BASK claiming the bronze medals.

The childrens kumite started with the boys and girls 7 years and below Charlie Cochrane (FSKA) won four fights to beat the other 16 competitors in his division, with Rayan Djouadj in silver and bronze shared by Leo Greenwood and Hugo Bernie, all from FSKA London.

The 8-9 year olds under 4'3" kumite event Thomas Marwood (FSKA) won three fights and then beat Lewis Finch from Seaford in the final with Seyon Srisanger (BASK) and Sam Lea (Seaford) both winning bronze medals. In the over 4'3" Rhys Salmon from Tokon Kai won all his fights beating Jamie Brown from KICKS Brighton with FSKA team mates Thomas Cotter and Thomas Holloway taking bronze medals.

In the boys and girls 10-12 years old under 4'10" we saw 16 children battle it out. Jamie Allison from North Birmingham won his four fights to see him take yet another gold medal beating Rohan Mathiyalagan (BASK) in the final. Bronze was shared by Tyler Stacey from Tokon Kai and Sam Mehta from SKO Southall.

In the 10-12 years over 4'10" Ryan Francis Hume from FSKA narrowly defeated Riccardo Francolini from North Birmingham the Rohan Dhupar (FSKA) and Oskar Langley (Seaford) taking home bronze medals.

The 13-15 year old boys kumite under 5'3" saw Tokon Kai dominate with Zac Stacey winning the gold as team mate Lewis Johnstone took silver. Ishan Nandia (SKO) and Oscar Ricca-McCarthy KICKS Brighton both took bronze medals.

The 13-15 year old boys over 5'3" produced some great fights. A well deserved Gold went to Sam Smith from Tokon Kai beating Seaford's Damian Shepherd in the final, while bronze was shared by Jack Mason (Sneyd) and Daniel Fountain (Tokon Kai).

The girls 13-15 year old kumite saw Janani Hariskandaraj (BASK) win her three fights to take the gold medal beating Lagani Navaneethakrishan (BASK) in the final. Semi finalists Tulsi Pankhania from SKO Southall and Georgia Starkey (Tokon Kai) both shared bronze medals.

The female novice and intermediate kumite was won by Nathalie Boden from Seaford beating Arani Navaneethakrishan (BASK) into second place. Bronze medals went to Lauren Rickards (Seaford) and Kerry Louise-Phillips from KICKS Brighton.

In the Female Senior Kumite Sian Pomeroy (Seaford) won her third gold medal of the day and swept aside all others to win the event with Chloe Sutherland (CMA) winning silver while Lisa Coster and Lynda Hamilton both from FSKA shared the bronze medals.

The male novice and intermediate events saw Bafana Thawuzeni from FSKA dominate the event with silver going to Sasikaran Thurairatnam (BASK) and bronze shared between Richard Marwood and Jonathan Hubble both from FSKA London.

The male senior lightweight kumite saw Colin Simmonds from North Birmingham narrowly beat two up and coming fighters. In the first round Colin beat Callum Ware from Ryobu Kai Woodingdean, and then in the final Karl Mason who looked sharp and up for the fight but Colin's experience saw him through to win the gold. Karl took silver while Callum and Steve Jakes from Seaford shared the bronze.

The male senior heavyweight kumite saw 12 competitors battle it out for supremacy. Edmend Nela from ASK Brighton defeated all in his way winning his fights 9-0, 8-0 and 2-0 in the final beating Chris Maulkin from Red Oak karate club in Lewes. Bronze medals were won by Patric Caines (North Birmingham) and Simon Heardon from KICKS in Brighton who both won some close and hard fights.

The Master Kumite for the over 40's saw Colin Simmonds retain his impressive record and beat his club mate Patric Caines, both from North Birmingham Karate Club, in the final. Bronze medals went to Malcolm Johnstone from Tokon Kai and Steve Jakes from Seaford.

The day was finished by 5.30pm, and only a few minor injuries that were mostly dealt with by the first aid, everyone was on their way home smiling and happy. Many thanks to everyone who attended our tournament and I sincerely hope you all enjoyed competing and look forward to another event next year.
